In determining the result, score the various items under DEMERITS which fit the wife and add to get a DEMERITS total. Each item counts for one point except where specifically weighted as in parenthesis. Then score the items under MERITS which apply and add to get a MERITS total. Now subtract the DEMERITS total from the MERITS total to get the wife's raw score.

Interpret this score according to the following table.

Raw Scores	Interpretation
0 -24	Very Poor (Failure)
25 - 41	Poor
42 - 58	Average
59 - 75	Superior (a definite keeper)
74 plus	Superb (you might want to validate gender just in case)
